


## Substance use in the past 12 months: Charleston, SC Survey dates: November 4–5, 2022 N=304

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## (Special Hotspot Alert Location)

The Rapid Street Reporting (RSR) team visited Charleston, SC on November 4-5 as the second RSR Hotspot location. Charleston was chosen for a Hotspot visit based on rates of drug overdose-related EMS dispatch records in October 2022. The top three reported drugs aligned with previous NDEWS Sentinel Site visits: marijuana (49.7%), powder cocaine (15.1%), and psilocybin (14.1%).







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## **Demographics of Charleston, SC Participants**
