

Alert from the NDEWS Web Monitoring Team: Online mentions of HHC

What was found? Hexahydrocannabinol (HHC) was last reported on by NDEWS in Weekly Briefing Issue 78. Since then, the drug has seen significantly increased growth in both volume of discussion and number of commenters.

What is HHC? HHC is a derivative drug of THC that can be produced synthetically. It is typically synthesized from delta-8 or delta-9 THC. Claims about its potency, effects, and risks vary.

How is it being discussed? Commenters often report HHC's effects as being stronger than delta-8 THC, delta-10 THC, and some other "noids", with effects including visual hallucinations.
