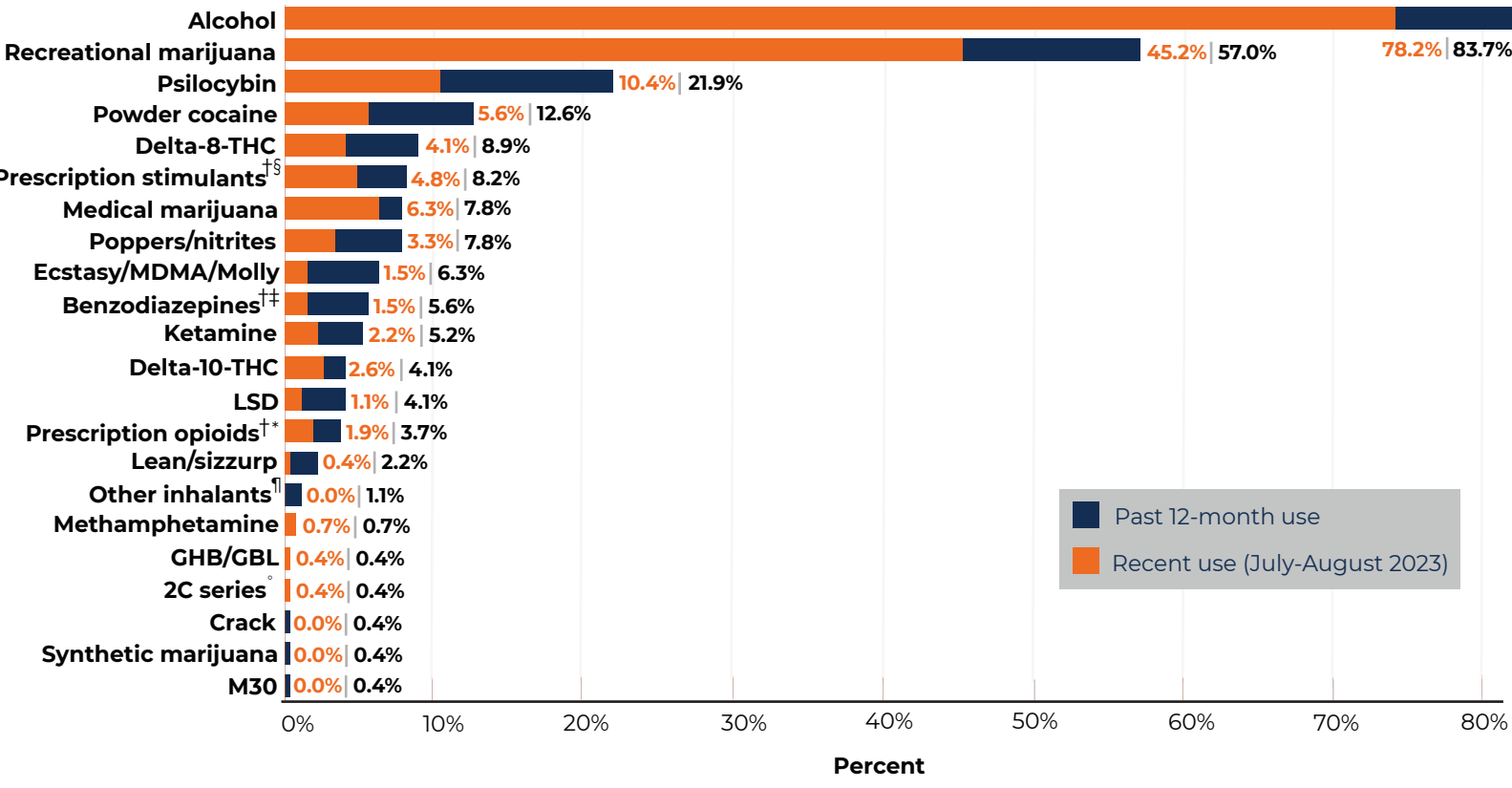


Substance use in the past 12 months: New York City, NY Survey dates: August 25–27, 2023 N=270



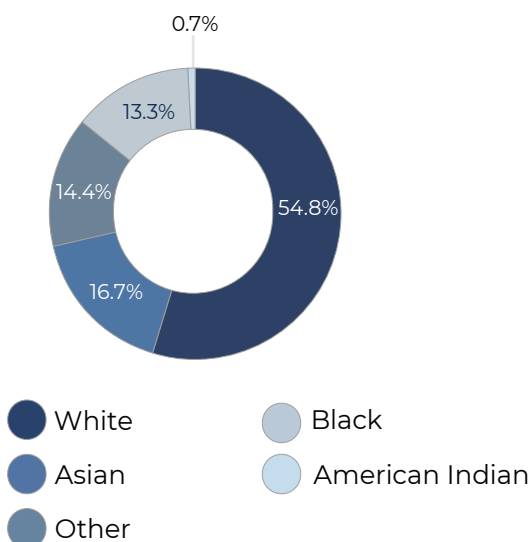
The Rapid Street Reporting (RSR) team visited New York City, NY on August 25–27, 2023. After alcohol and marijuana, the next most commonly reported substances used in the past 12 months were psilocybin (21.9%), powder cocaine (12.6%), and delta-8-THC (8.9%).



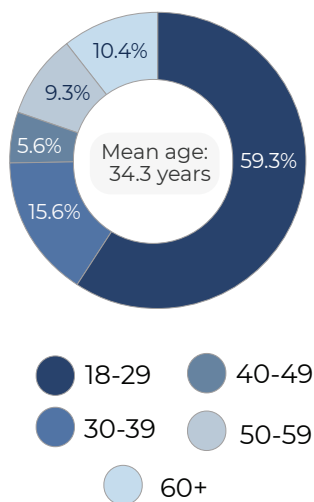

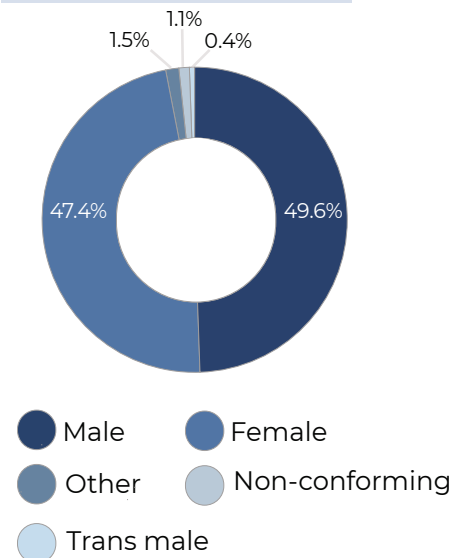
Race/ethnicity



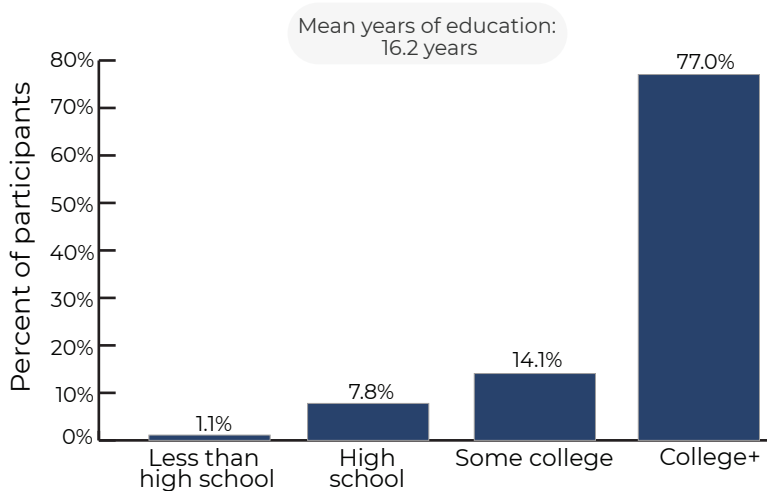
Age



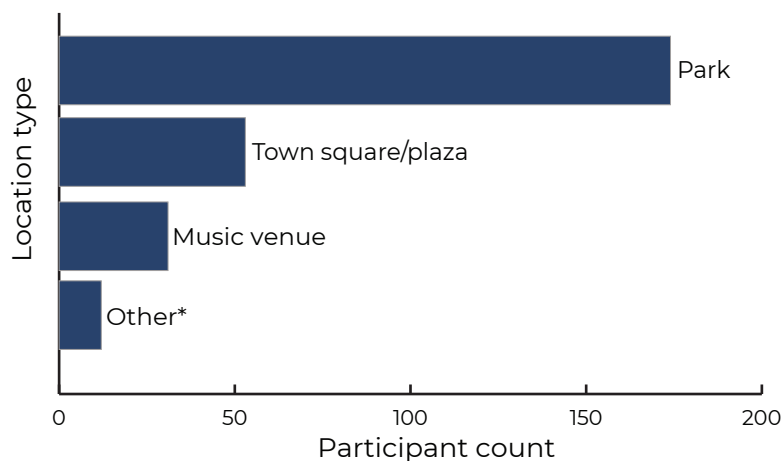
Gender identity
