


Substance use in the past 12 months: Philadelphia, PA Survey dates: October 27–29, 2023 N=78

Philadelphia

The Rapid Street Reporting (RSR) team visited Philadelphia, PA on October 27–29, 2023 and surveyed 78 individuals. After alcohol and marijuana, the next most commonly reported substances used in the past 12 months were powder cocaine (12.8%), psilocybin (11.5%), and benzodiazepines (7.7%).





- † Nonmedical use.
- ‡ Benzodiazepines include Xanax/alprazolam, Valium/diazepam, Klonopin/clonazepam, Ativan/lorazepam, and other benzodiazepines.
- * Prescription opioids include Vicodin/other hydrocodone, and OxyContin/other oxycodone such as Percocet or roxicodone.
- § Prescription stimulants include nonmedical use of Adderall, Ritalin, or another drug for ADHD.
- ¶ Other opioids include heroin.
- > Other inhalants include nitrous oxide/whippits.
- x Other psychedelics include ayahuasca.
