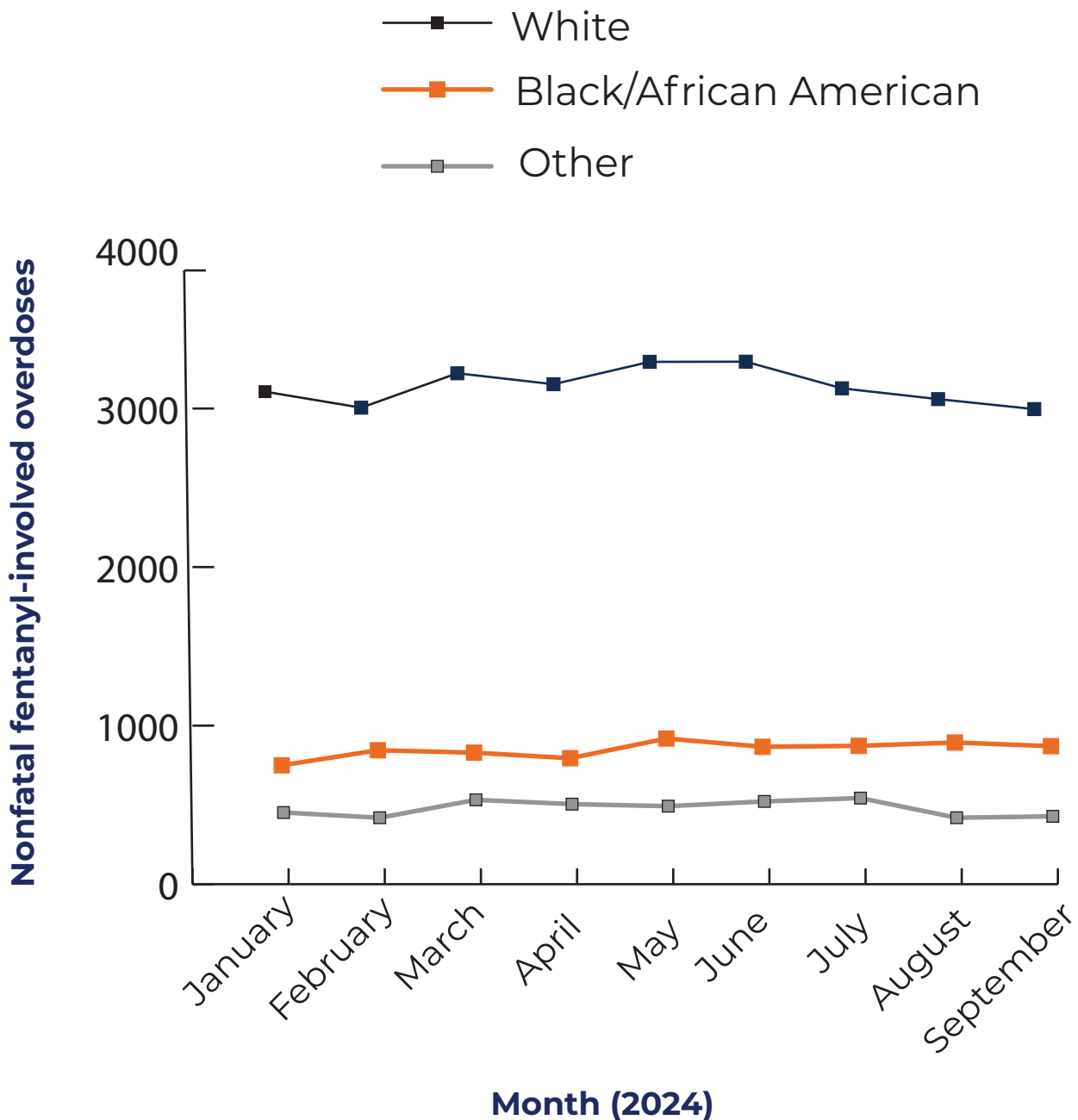


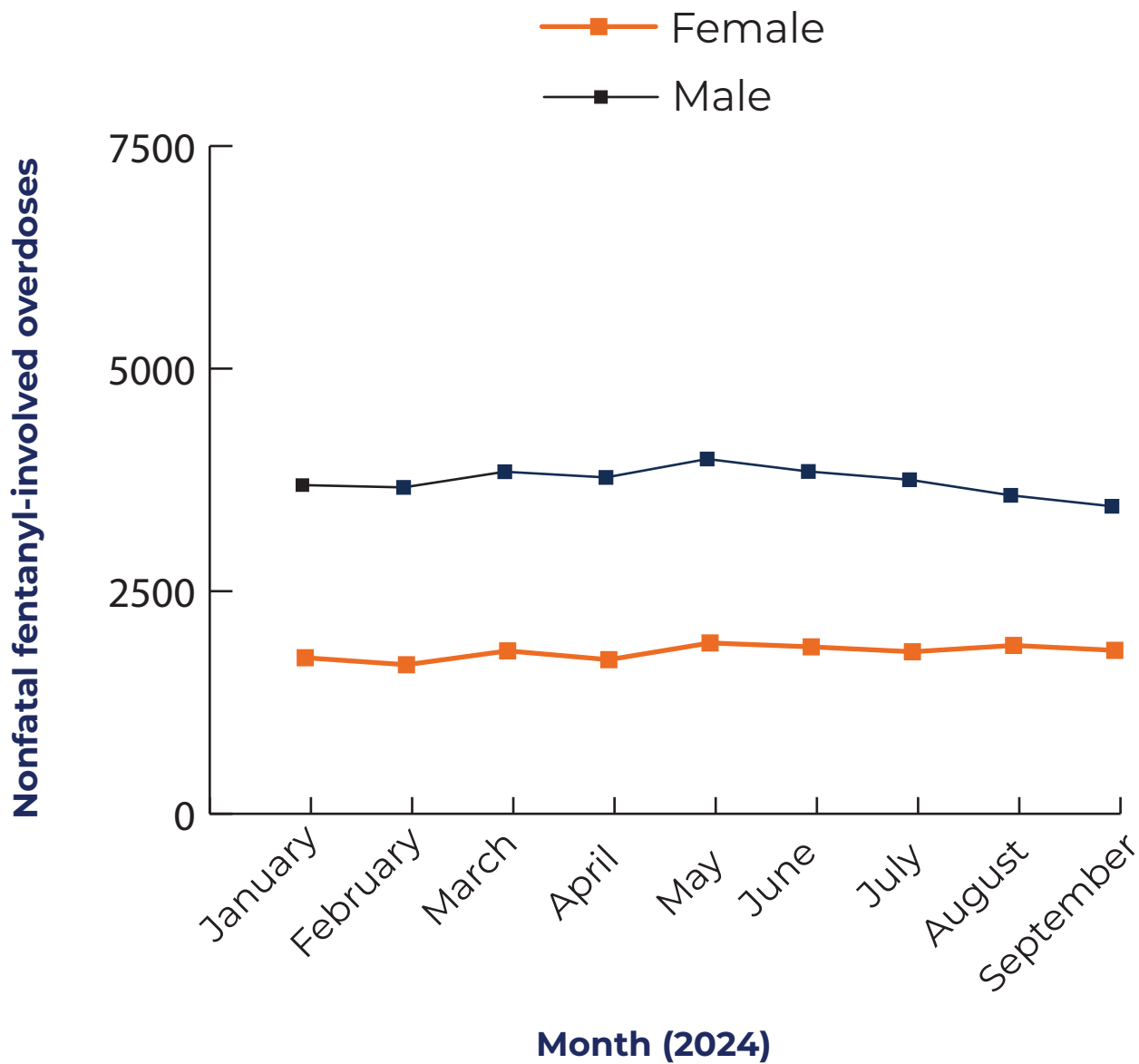
NDEWS Special Report Nonfatal fentanyl-involved overdoses January 1 – September 30, 2024

This week, NDEWS highlights 50,572 nonfatal fentanyl-involved overdoses from January 1 to September 30, 2024. The line graph below shows the nonfatal fentanyl-involved overdoses by month and race. The line graph on page 2 shows the nonfatal fentanyl-involved overdoses by month and gender.

All dispatch types above follow the guidelines set by the National Emergency Medical Services Information System (NEMSIS). Data is limited to 28 US states/districts with statewide partnerships with biospatial.io: Alabama, Alaska, Arkansas, California, Colorado, District of Columbia, Florida, Georgia, Idaho, Illinois, Kansas, Kentucky, Maine, Michigan, Minnesota, Mississippi, Montana, New Mexico, New York, North Carolina, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, South Carolina, Tennessee, Utah, Virginia, Wisconsin, and Wyoming.

Nonfatal fentanyl-involved overdose dispatches are based on the Rhode Island Department of Health definition for detecting incidents involving nonfatal fentanyl overdoses.
