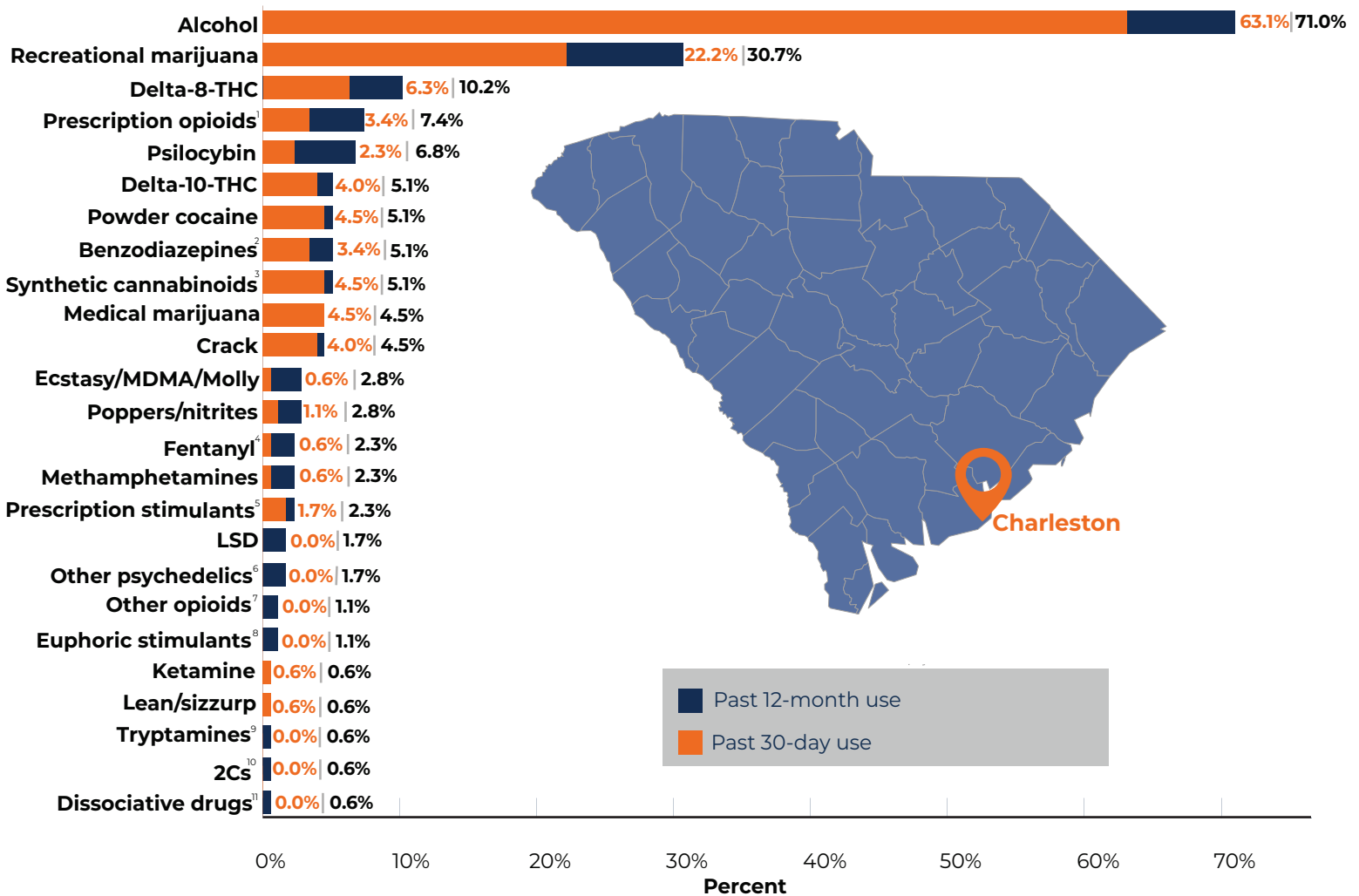


### Substance use in the past 12 months: Charleston, SC

Survey dates: March 28 to 30, 2025  
N=176

The Rapid Street Reporting (RSR) team visited Charleston, SC between March 28<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup>, 2025 and surveyed 176 individuals. After alcohol and marijuana, the next most commonly reported substances used in the past 12 months were delta-8 (10.2%), prescription opioids (7.4%) and psilocybin (6.8%).



1 Prescription opioids include Vicodin/other hydrocodone, OxyContin, tramadol, and codeine with Tylenol.

2 Benzodiazepines include Xanax/alprazolam and Klonopin/clonazepam.

3 Synthetic cannabinoids include Spice and K2.

4 Nonmedical use.

5 Prescription stimulants include nonmedical use of Adderall, Ritalin, or another drug for ADHD.

6 Other psychedelics include 1P-LSD and ALD-52.

7 Other opioids include heroin and other unspecified opioid drugs.

8 Euphoric stimulants include MDA and TMA.

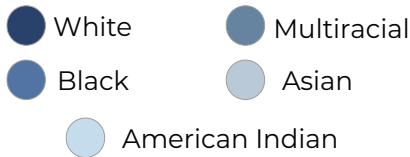
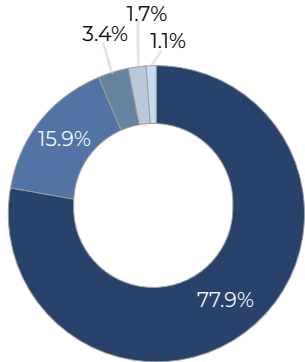
9 Tryptamines include DMT, AMT, and 5-MeO-DMT.

10 2C series include 2C-E/Europa, 2C-1/smiles, and 2C-T-7/T7, Blue Mystic, 7th heaven.

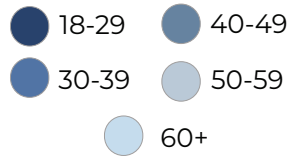
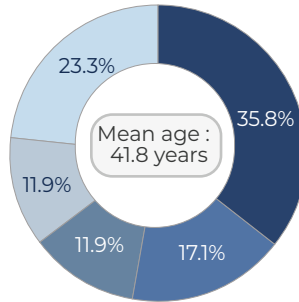
11 Dissociative drugs include 2-MeO-Ketamine, 3-MeO-PCP, 4-MeO-PCP.

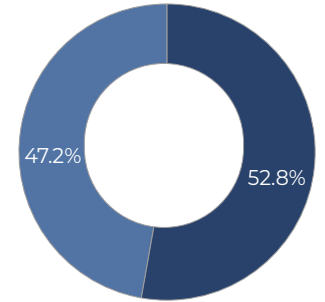
#### Race/ethnicity



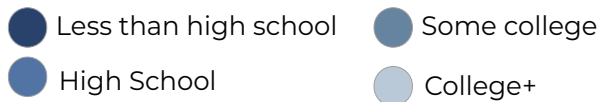
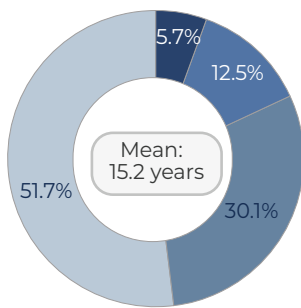
#### Age
